Luke 21:5-19

<sup>5</sup>When some were speaking about the temple, how it was adorned with beautiful stones and gifts dedicated to God, he said,

<sup>6</sup>"As for these things that you see, the days will come when not one stone will be left upon another; all will be thrown down."

<sup>7</sup>They asked him, "Teacher, when will this be, and what will be the sign that this is about to take place?"

<sup>8</sup>And he said, "Beware that you are not led astray; for many will come in my name and say, 'I am he!' and, 'The time is near!' Do not go after them.

<sup>9</sup>"When you hear of wars and insurrections, do not be terrified; for these things must take

place first, but the end will not follow immediately."

<sup>15</sup>for I will give you words and a wisdom that none of your opponents will be able to withstand or contradict.

<sup>16</sup>You will be betrayed even by parents and brothers, by relatives and friends; and they will put some of you to death.

<sup>17</sup>You will be hated by all because of my name.

<sup>18</sup>But not a hair of your head will perish.

<sup>19</sup>By your endurance you will gain your souls.


